

COLLEGE AT A GLANCE

Vidya Bharati College, the pride of Kamrup (R) District is established amidst different hurdles in 1990. Since then the college has been growing successfully. The college is permanently affiliated to the University of Gauhati during 2003-04 sessions and govt. Concurrence was accorded in 2005 w.e.f. the session 1997-98.





In its quest for glory, college has become indebted to various institutions and individual. The college acknowledges gratefulness to all who directly and indirectly have extended their helping hands, bore enormous pain and bestowed upon the society this esteemed institution.

The college is proud to have a main building with a big playground with an extension of an administrative corner. As a little distance towards south, a sports complex and a women's hostel are constructed. There are 9 Departments in Arts stream in the college.

Following the directives of Gauhati University the college has introduced Semester System from the year 2011 in its Degree course. From this year i.e., on and from 2019-20 session, the college is going to introduce CBCS in Degree courses. It is a matter of pride that within a very short span of time Vidya Bharati College has blossomed to fragrance and establishes itself as a premier institution of higher education.

VISION PLAN

The college has prepared a vision plan for the coming 5 (Five) years-

(1) Conversion of this college to a centre of quality education with well equipped infrastructure and innovative teaching learning atmosphere. (2) To set up well equipped seperate Department along with own classroom. (3) Introducing e-library facilities. (4) To establish a health and welfare unit with ambulance facilities. (5) To establish a Computer Laboratory. (6) To construct a well equipped Administrative Block and a Digital Library. (7) To Prepare the college for NAAC accreditation.



TEACHING, RESEARCH AND ORGANIZATION

- 1. **Teaching-** Teaching is a process of emancipation of knowledge. Quality teaching is the primary involvement of the entire college family. The college has introduced some innovative practices in teaching students. Teaching plan, Teacher's Diary, review, syllabi distribution, short term assessment, microteaching etc have been introduced for the development of the teaching learning process.
- 2. **Research** The faculties of the college are engaged itself in various forms of research works in different areas. A good number of faculties have already obtained their M.Phil and Ph.D degrees and some faculties are pursuing research. Moreover almost all departments have a research council to monitor the projects and research activities of the students in undergraduate level.
- 3. **Organization-**Vidya Bharati College has at present various organization and associations for the all-round development of the College.



- 4. College Magazine- Vidya Bharati college magazine named 'VIDYAJYOTI' is published regularly by the Students Union of the college which is considered as the mouthpiece of the college. A hand written magazine named 'POHAR' is regularly published from the Department of Education of the college. 'EDUCARE' a newsletter is also published by Educational Forum of the college highlighting the activities of the Department. Department of Philosophy has published also departmental magazine named DRISTI in the year 2016.
- 5. Wall Magazine- Vidya Bhrati College publishes issues of its wall magazine named 'VIDYASHREE' which is published regularly as an attempt to encourage the students to pen their ideas on both contemporary and enduring issues.

INFRASTRUCTURE AND FACILITIES:

Classroom, Library, Gym, Students Welfare Fund, Psychological Counseling Centre, Remedial Classes, Well equipped Office and Principal Room, Faculty Chambers, Wi-Fi facilities, Power Supply Generator with 62.5 KVA for supplying power back up, Girls Hostel, Indoor and Outdoor Sports Complex, Clean and Open Air Environment.

GIRL'S HOSTEL:

The college is going to introduce the Hostel Facilities for Girl's. The hostel has 40 seats. Boarders will avail the hostel facilities along with primary medical care, yoga, library and co-curricular facilities with minimum cost in a homely environment.



ADMISSION PROCEDURE:

Applications for admission to the college is to be submitted in the prescribed form with a specific date as notified in advance. The merit list will be displayed on the notice board well ahead of the admission date. Admission will be held on merit basis. A student has to produce the following documents at the time of the admission- a) HSLC/HS Admit card b) HS Registration Certificate c) Original mark sheet of last examination passed d) Original certificates from the Head of the Institution last attended e) Gap certificate if needed f) Passport photograph 4 copies g) Caste certificate h) Migration transfer certificate i) Certificate of proficiency in extra ordinary cocurricular activities j) Necessary documents applicable for free Admission (Subject to the approval of Govt. of Assam and announcement time to time made by the DHE). Selection of students who want to pursue major in any subject will be done in order of merit at the time of admission. Admission to the college hostel will be held immediately after the college admission for which separate application form is to be submitted.



GENERAL INFORMATIONS FOR THE STUDENTS

About Admission: Prospectus and Application Forms can be obtained from the college office on the payment of Rs. 200/-. Admission will be on the basis of merit and first come first basis. There is provision of reservation for SC, ST, OBC, MOBC and physically handicapped candidates as per government norms. Provision of Reservation also exists for the candidates having remarkable achievement in the field of music, sports and other extra-curricular activities. General Rules and Regulations: (a) Special stress is laid upon discipline and moral character of the students. Students must obey all the rules and regulations as prescribed by the college authority. Necessary action as judged appropriate by the college authority will be taken against any violation of rules, irregularity in class attendence, adoption of unfair means in the examinations and any other objectionable activities. (b) All kinds of ragging in the college are strictly prohibited. (c) Any kind of students' organization or society in college is confined to the rules and regulation of the college. (d) In the implementation of all the rules and regulations, the decisions of the head of the institution is final.

Attendance: Students are necessarily to attend at least 75% of classes. Failing to which they will be non-collegiated and will have to pay a non-collegiate fine of Rs. 500/- to be qualified for appearing in the final examination.

Examination: At least two unit tests and a sessional examination will be held during each semester. Students will have to attend such examination compulsorily to be qualified for appearing in final Examination.

Uniform: Attending classes in prescribed Uniform Dress is compulsory for all the Students.
